

Registration for the ADAC Cyclassics 2026 has opened

Registration for the ADAC Cyclassics 2026 is now open. On 16 August, Hamburg will once again host a major cycling weekend – featuring two distances, more than 10,000 participants, and the special atmosphere that has shaped the event for three decades.

As in previous years, participants can choose between the ADAC Cyclassics 60 and the ADAC Cyclassics 110, appealing to both ambitious hobby cyclists and beginners. Both routes are intended to build on the great success of 2025 and are currently being planned in detail.

"2025 was a fantastic year for the ADAC Cyclassics. The adjustments we made really paid off – the atmosphere along and on the course was simply outstanding," says Matthias Pietsch, Managing Director of A.S.O. Germany GmbH. "We want to revive this positive feeling in 2026: a safe, smooth-running race that all participants will remember."

The entry-level prices for the 2026 race remain unchanged despite the general trend, but will increase gradually based on dates or participant thresholds. The popular duo entry for the long distance will also return in 2026. Those who register early not only secure a lower price, but also a guaranteed starting place.
